Food Challenge




Today we are making **Smarties Cookies**

You will need:

200g light brown sugar
200g butter
2 tbs golden syrup
250g self-raising flour
3 tubes of Smarties
Baking sheet and an ice-cream scoop

- 1. Mix the butter and the sugar together well so they are creamy and light.**
- 2. Add in the golden syrup and mix well.**
- 3. Add in the flour and the Smarties.**
- 4. Use an ice-cream scoop to create balls of dough and put them onto the baking sheet leaving a generous gap between scoops.**
- 5. Cook for 12 minutes in a 180-degree oven until they are light brown.**

Let's make

Make two sock creatures using a pair of old socks (or two odd socks!).

You will need:

- **two old colourful socks**
- **some rice**
- **some googly eyes**
- **scissors**
- **elastic band**
- **some glue.**

Fill your sock with several handfuls of rice until you have a reasonably full ball of rice at the end of the sock. Use string or an elastic band to tie it closed so the rice is secure.

Use your scissors to cut strips down the rest of the sock to make tentacles. Finally glue googly eyes onto the sock ball to bring your sock creature to life! What are you going to call your wonderful sock creatures?

Once you have made your creatures, you could tell a story with them. Why not retell today's Cheeky Pandas episode or tell your own story of being a faithful friend?

Can you colour the cheeky pandas as they try and remember today's memory verse?
