

GUIDANCE FOR HOLY COMMUNION AT ST MICHAEL & ALL ANGELS CHURCH PELSALL

'I was glad when they said unto me, Let us go into the house of the LORD.' Psalm 122

Public worship will resume on **Sunday 14th March 2021**.

The service is a simple Said Holy Communion, starting at 10am, and lasts for approximately 50-60 minutes. It will be the **only** service for the day.

This is our first attempt to open for public worship so once again we are applying a **cautious and measured approach**. Our top priority is keeping you safe whilst being with us, so we're taking great care to put social distancing, hand sanitizer arrangements and cleaning measures in place. At present we cannot offer a range of services but will work towards this in line with current diocesan advice.

Next Sunday may look and feel different due to the public health and Church of England guidelines. It will also mean that **seating will be limited** although we intend to cater for as many as legally and feasibly possible.

Therefore it will be helpful and useful if you please make contact with Rev. Alison by 12 noon on the Friday if you intend to come.

This means that the churchwardens can prepare seating in line with social distancing according to the requested numbers. If you are coming as a couple and wish to sit together or as a family bubble do please indicate so that we can allocate those seats in line with the recommendations.

As a church community this will be something very new to our way of worship so if there are any questions do please contact Rev. Alison.

Finally, may we ask you please to commit this to prayer. We are looking forward to seeing many of you back in the church but we ask you please to be patient and good-hearted in your response as we cautiously move forward together in our worship.
